ROOTS OF EASTER

YOU MIGHT NOT KNOW.

There are some fun facts and legends surrounding the Easter period that you may not be familiar with:

- 1 There is a lovely legend; that a Saxon Goddess - Eostre happened upon a wounded bird. To help the animal get through winter, she turned the bird into a hare! The hare discovered that it could lay eggs, and so it decorated the eggs each spring and left them as an offering to the Goddess.
- 2 England takes its name for Easter from the Anglo-Saxon Goddess of the dawn (mentioned above) - Eostre. The month of March was known as Estor-monath - loosely translated as the month of openings. The rituals and symbols of this time - eggs, hare, sun etc. all focus on the cycle of seasons, a period of renewal and beginnings, fertility and fruitfulness.
- 3 Egyptians, Greeks, Iranians and Romans were all known to dye eggs around Easter. Sometimes these were painted in spring-like colours, but often, the eggs were painted red to symbolise Christ's blood, fertility and re-birth.
- 4 Some of the most famous and elaborate decorated eggs are the enamelled version made by Fabergé. Originally, they were commissioned by Alexander iii and Nicholas ii - both Russian Tsars. The eggs were created as gifts for their wives, but it is a trend that spread amongst other royalty and aristocrats in early modern Europe.
- 5 The March Hare is synonymous with this time of year; and, of course, is linked to fertility, as it is their mating season. Often, hares are depicted in an upright boxing position, which; usually occurs when a female is unreceptive to a male's advances. This erratic behaviour has coined several phrases: 'hair-brained' and 'mad as a march hare'. This phrase is known by many, thanks to Alice in Wonderland by Lewis Carroll.
- 6 An animal that you might not associate with Easter is the snake! But in years gone by, they were seen as symbolic of springtime. They would awaken from winter hibernation and literally shed their skin - in a process that was seen, as healing and representative of renewal.
- 7 For many, it is not the hare - but the Easter Bunny that is associated with Easter. Traditions came from 16th-century Germans but were taken to America as they travelled. Children would leave out Easter bonnets and nests they had fashioned from grass. In turn, these would be filled with treats from the Easter Bunny. Interestingly, in a similar tradition to Christmas - treats would only be given to children that 'had been good'!



Understanding your Dreams

Today's dream is all about discovering an unused room. On the surface, it doesn't seem like the most exciting of dreams. However, it is a very positive dream to have - maybe it is time to explore your untapped potential.

Most people who have an 'unused room' dream are dreaming of the house they own or live in. You may see yourself walking through the house; when suddenly you notice a door that you are; sure wasn't there before. You don't believe that you have ever opened the door, and you approach the handle; with a mix of nervousness and anticipation.



Quite often, the location of the door - concerning your actual house will make no sense. When you open the door; you may discover one big room or a sequence of smaller rooms.

v - The Hierophant

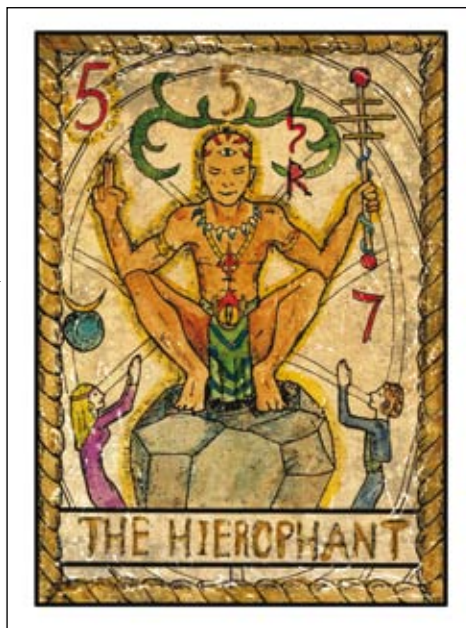
The Hierophant is an unusual word and not one that immediately conjures up a meaning. But if I told you; that in some decks, this card is referred to as the Pope then; you begin to imagine the spirituality and mystery behind it.

This card rarely describes a person; it is usually about a situation - a scenario; where you should do your best to behave in a prudent way that abides by the rules - whilst keeping the spotlight off yourself.

You will notice; in most depictions of this card, the Hierophant is holding a triple cross; this represents different aspects of your life: physical, spiritual and material. It is a reminder that we need to make time; for incorporating; some form of spiritual devotion into our daily lives, in order to feel balance.

This card can very often act as a warning, particularly if you are experiencing difficulties in relationships (of any variety). The message is; it is almost always a good idea to take the moral high ground and to practise what you preach. I.e. behave and act as you wish others would around you!

If you needed to sum up this card in a few words, they would be patience, self-control, understanding, forgiveness and compassion.

iv - The Emperor

As you might imagine from the card depiction and the name, The Emperor represents power, authority and influence. By drawing this card, you may either meet someone with these qualities or; you possess them yourself - but perhaps you do not recognise these abilities as ones you own.

If you have been kicking around a business idea, have been looking for a new job, or want a promotion and more responsibility at work - then The Emperor card is a great omen, suggesting you are ready for what you wish. This card is also a timely reminder that to get others; to have faith in us, we must first believe in ourselves!

Those in life that have Emperor qualities are likely in jobs that exert influence - people look up to them. Whilst they recognise the significance of this, they are not egotistical. They want to earn people's respect from their achievements, not from; their job or worldly goods.

One word of caution around this card; The Emperor is ruled by Aries - with a tendency to rush in; and act; in a headstrong way. It is up to you to recognise when going to battle over what you want and need is important and when a less sentimental, strategic approach is required.

Blume's Retro Blockbuster

Did you read Judy Blume's books when you were younger? Despite the author being American, I remember having access to the whole series in the school library. Now, the best-selling classic *Are You There God? It's Me, Margaret* has been adapted for the big screen by Lionsgate.

Book to Film

The book; was written in 1970, and for many years Judy Blume was chased to surrender the rights to the book so it could be adapted for film. Her biggest concern was that the film would 'sand off the edges and make it glossy and pretty'. However, things changed when Judy; was approached by writer/director: Kelly Fremon Craig. Judy coincidentally had just seen his first film - *The Edge of Seventeen*, and so felt more confident that he would embrace all of the nuances and honesty; held in the book.

Synopsis

If you are unfamiliar with the book, it is a timeless, coming-of-age story about Margaret (played by Abby Ryder Fortson), who is aged 11. She has moved to a new town and is moving through adolescence and all of the confusion that brings. Margaret is also beginning to question life, family, friendships and the greater meaning of things. The story is made all the more colourful by the close relationships; she has with her grandmother (played by Kathy Bates); and her mother (played by our cover star - Rachel McAdams). If you have ever wondered where you fit in? Then, this is the book/film for you!

Direction

The book, when it was written; was of that time (1970), so Craig had to decide whether to base the film now or back in the '70s. He chose the latter, as it helped to demonstrate how universal these themes are.

Margaret has a crisis of faith due to the inter-faith marriage of her parents, and the book deals with teenage female issues of wanting to grow breasts, getting a first bra, menstruation and more. It is these very themes; that has got this book censored in some locations. Craig felt that by basing the film in the original timeframe, he could better show that these life events are as relevant today as they were then. People will likely find the universal feeling; that you are not alone; and that someone else is going through the same things; comforting.

SPRINGTIME SUPERSTITIONS

Do you tend to abide by superstitions? Like not walking on cracks in pavements or under ladders? Then, this article is for you. We look at some superstitions and omens, good and bad luck surrounding Spring!

Whilst you might be annoyed at a **BEE** entering your home, it actually represents good luck. It can also mean you will get a visit from a stranger! It might be tempting to chase the bee from your home, but it is very unlucky if you do - they must come and go naturally. Killing a bee is thought to bring several years of bad luck.

March through to August; is a great time to search for a **FOUR-LEAF CLOVER**. If you are lucky enough to find one, a great suggestion is to dry it and then; keep it safe in either plastic or grease-proof paper. Keeping it on your person or in a wallet or handbag should act as a potent talisman.

Hearing a **CUCKOO** is the ultimate message that Spring has sprung. However, you don't want to hear from them before the 6th of April - this is considered very bad luck. Hearing them on the 28th of April is considered very lucky indeed. When you first hear a cuckoo, you want to turn over any money; you have in your pocket - which will bring you prosperity for the future year. Make a wish; at the same time as the cuckoo call; and it should be granted!

If you are planting up your Spring/Summer garden, you might want to consider the **FLOWER** colour scheme. Pink for faithful love, red for passion, purple for respect - you might wish to know that yellow represents disdain. If you are cutting flowers to give to someone or buying a bouquet - always make sure you gift an odd number of flowers. If you purchase a dozen flowers, keep one for yourself.

RECOGNISING STRESS

You may not realise it, but many of us exhibit specific behaviours when we feel stressed. Being able to recognise stress is the first step in being able to help yourself. - It is easy to feel overwhelmed.

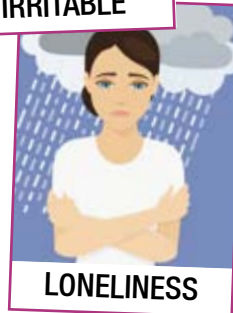
Your behaviours may be changed by stress
