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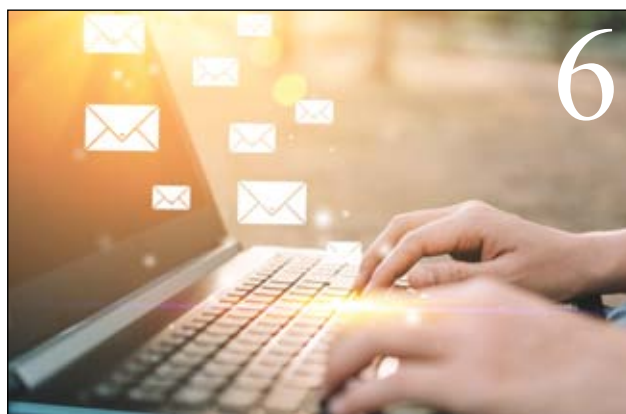

The Tradition of Chinese New Year

Chinese New Year is sometimes referred to as the Lunar New Year or even Spring Festival. In the Eastern calendar this period is very significant, spiritually speaking. In 2026, the new Lunar Cycle begins on the 17th February on the first New Moon and ushers in the Year of the Horse!

As I'm sure you are aware, the Lunar Year is guided by both a zodiac animal, 2026 being the horse and also the five elements: Earth, Fire, Metal, Water and Wood – all part of a 60-year cycle. It is this layered animal/element that adds nuance and depth to each New Year.

The Significance of the 'Fire' Horse

The combination of the fire element and the horse animal in 2026, will make 2026 a powerful and intense year with plenty of transformations. Fire always represents passion and courage – but also visibility and the Horse signify speed/agility, freedom and independence. Together they will create an energy of forward momentum.

Fire Horse years usually represent periods of rapid change, heightened emotions and bold decisions. They definitely do not make for quiet years – collectively, it is likely to be very memorable! 2026, in general favours innovation and decisive action, on a more spiritual level people will likely be looking to live in a more authentic manner and trying to align their work, home and family life to their moral values. Horse Symbolism

In Chinese folklore the Horse is seen as a companion, to both travellers and warriors. Spiritually this animal symbolises a soul's desire for progress. You might summon 'Horse' energy, when you need to make a difficult decision, when you need to pivot and change direction, if it's time to move on from something or somebody, or when you need to take back your power!

Horse Signs and Love

Those born in Horse years are known for their passion, but also, they are quite romantic and expressive about their feelings. 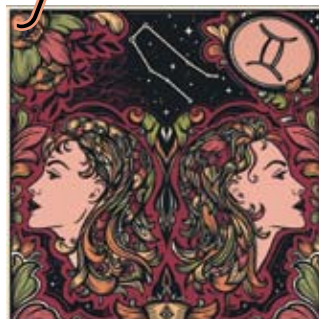
Astrology

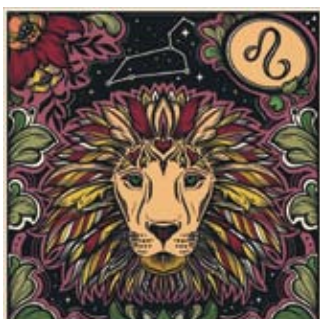
